Spay and Neuter Solutions was founded as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization on July 1, 2003. Pet overpopulation is an issue of great concern to virtually every animal welfare organization, many of which are overwhelmed by the number of homeless or abused pets in our communities. The goal of Spay and Neuter Solutions is to help make Arizona a pioneer state that can soon claim "no more homeless animals." We work closely with other animal welfare organizations, each of which has its own mission and goals. The sole focus of Spay and Neuter solutions is in its name: we concentrate all of our efforts on spay and neuter issues.

We are dedicated to **PREVENTION** and EDUCATION. We provide for free and low-cost spay/neuter surgeries for companion animals in our community. We have negotiated discounted rates with participating veterinary clinics, and we pay all or part of the cost, depending on the need of the client. We also educate pet owners about the importance of spay/ neuter in preventing the birth of unwanted animals and in improving the quality of life for their pets. From The President:

I have received a number of inquiries about the status of the low-cost clinic for which so many of you donated generously last year. I am writing this update to share with you the limited information I have on this matter:

A year ago I invited you to help raise money for a high volume, low cost community spay and neuter clinic that The Center for Animal Rescue and Adoption (CARA) had planned to establish with support from the National Spay/Neuter Response Team in North Carolina. At the time Spay and Neuter Solutions was collaborating with CARA to help raise funds for the clinic.

Shortly after the fundraiser event in November 2009 this collaboration was broken off by CARA. Spay and Neuter Solutions has not been a working partner of CARA since then. Regrettably, CARA's efforts to establish the low-cost clinic have not yet come to fruition. Spay and Neuter Solutions continues to fully support the concept of such a much-needed clinic.

As of the time this newsletter is going to press we have not been able to establish communication with Cynthia Barstad (formerly Cynthia Taylor), President of CARA, regarding information on the clinic and a financial accounting of the funds raised. To the best of our knowledge Ms. Barstad is currently not in Arizona. CARA's website is down, Ms. Barstad's phone has been disconnected and she has not replied to email messages. She has moved from her previous home, which also served as CARA's office. Her organization did not have other officers.

We hope that you will continue supporting our mission. In 2010, Spay and Neuter Solutions helped to spay and neuter 1,704 cats and dogs.
